

Postgraduate studies

The two-year Master of Arts is equivalent to a Masters Degree. It provides students with a specialized training through advanced-level courses that expand and support the inclinations and calling they discovered during their Bachelor of Arts studies. The Master of Arts trains professionals that are capable of performing complex activities in specific sectors.

Students of the Master of Arts can participate in workshops, masterclasses, interdisciplinary projects and competitions. They may intern in companies and public administration offices to gain experience in their field (also after graduating).

They can also participate in the Erasmus + project which offers students the possibility of undertaking part of their studies or an internship abroad.

The credit system

The commitment required is quantified through academic credits (CFA). A credit corresponds to 25 hours of studies (lectures, exercises, workshops, self-studying, etc.).

During an academic year, students must achieve 60 credits.

To complete a Master of Arts (two years), students will need to achieve 120 credits.

Studying and living at RUFA

Theory and creative practice are constantly intertwined at RUFA.

Attending the Academy means going beyond traditional University education.

Students participate in laboratory and face-to-face lectures, practical exercises, workshops and events with key players. For this reason, attendance at RUFA is mandatory.

It is a dynamic European capital in constant evolution. It is home to many important museums and art venues where contemporary art and trends are born and develop.

La formazione di secondo livello

Il Diploma Accademico di secondo livello (biennale), equipollente alla Laurea Magistrale, consente allo studente di acquisire una formazione di livello specialistico, attraverso un percorso formativo avanzato che approfondisce e asseconda le attitudini e le vocazioni sviluppate nel corso del triennio. Il biennio forma professionisti in grado di svolgere attività altamente qualificate in ambiti specifici. Gli studenti del biennio hanno l'opportunità di prendere parte a laboratori, masterclass, progetti interdisciplinari e concorsi, nonché a tirocini, anche post diploma, in aziende ed enti pubblici per imparare la professione sul campo. Potranno anche aderire al progetto Erasmus+ che offre un periodo di studio o tirocinio lavorativo all'estero.

Il sistema dei crediti

L'impegno richiesto dai diversi insegnamenti si quantifica in crediti formativi accademici (CFA). Un credito corrisponde a 25 ore di lavoro (lezioni frontali, esercitazioni, laboratori, studio individuale, ecc.). In un anno accademico, gli studenti devono raggiungere 60 crediti. Per conseguire il Diploma di secondo livello (biennale), lo studente avrà bisogno di altri 120 crediti.

Studiare e vivere in RUFA

In RUFA il sapere teorico e la pratica creativa si intrecciano continuamente. Frequentare l'Accademia significa quindi andare oltre la tradizionale formazione universitaria. Lo studente partecipa a lezioni laboratoriali e frontali, esercitazioni pratiche, workshop, incontri con i professionisti del settore. Per questo in RUFA la frequenza delle lezioni è obbligatoria.

During each academic year, 6 one-week master classes will involve students in many projects under the guidance of internationally renowned artists and professionals. In a strongly stimulating and practical environment, students will have the opportunity of studying in an in-depth manner all of the practical and theoretical aspects related to each curriculum and to contemporary art such as: installations, performances, video art, public art, art criticism and art market. companies and creative realities that value their ability to find innovative and surprising visual and design solutions. The artist works closely with companies and businesses, for the success of projects and events. The 21st century artist is one who transforms the perception of reality by creating new aesthetics and many different worlds. For this reason, studying Painting, Sculpture and Printmaking through this Master of Arts is an investment for the future of our culture. The Painting curriculum gives great importance to the history and mechanisms that originate painting, tackling them through the study of fundamental subjects such as iconography and anatomical drawing, phenomenology of contemporary arts, art management. But at the same time it also allows students to deepen their knowledge in innovative languages; graphical, pictorial, plastic or technological. Through the Sculpture curriculum students learn how dominate matter and space, and how finds their artistic voice. At the same time they learn how to enter the contemporary artistic scene by studying specific subjects such as performative techniques, sculpture techniques, psychology of art. The Printmaking curriculum prepares students to face any type of request in the field of art and graphics (including publishing), by relying on their ability to recognize beauty and recreate it through specific techniques and technologies. Traditional and innovative studies broaden the professional possibilities of the artists. Printmaking, experimental plate engraving techniques and illustration are some of the specific subjects.
